## **Disinfection of Keeler Devices for COVID-19**

In order to minimize to risk to you and your patients, it is important to regularly disinfect your equipment. Keeler recommends the following in line with official recommendations<sup>1</sup>:

## <u>Disinfection Technique with Water/ Isopropyl Alcohol solution 70% IPA Volume:</u>

- Disconnect any electrical devices from their power source
- Wipe the external surface with a clean absorbent, non-shedding cloth dampened with a water / isopropyl alcohol solution (70% IPA by volume)
- Ensure that excess solution does not enter the instrument
- Use caution to ensure cloth is not saturated with solution
- Surfaces must be carefully hand-dried using a clean non shedding cloth
- NOTE: Avoid contact with lens optical surfaces, or puff lens tubes
