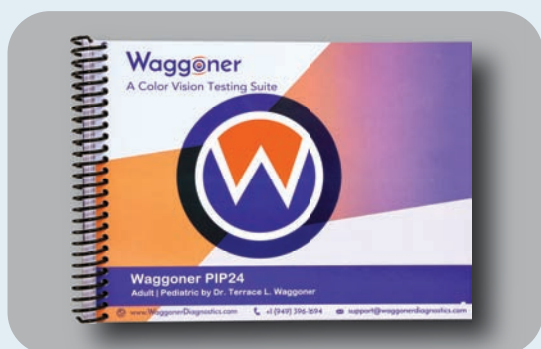


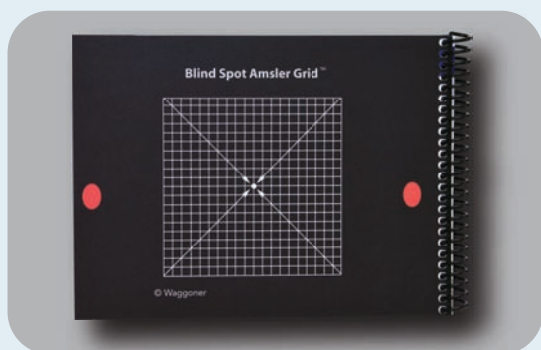
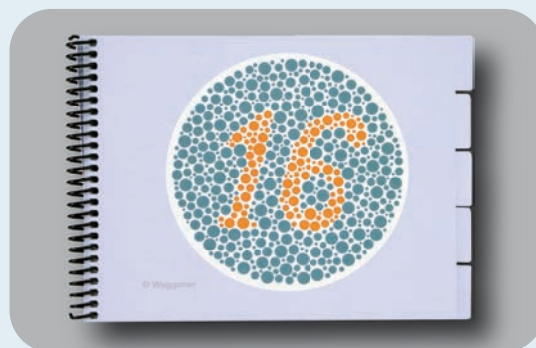
Waggoner PIP24
